Reapplying Application Instructions

If you are a previous recipient of the *Dora R-Good Neighbor Scholarship* and are reapplying for a scholarship for the 2019-2020 academic year, the only prerequisites are: (1) you have a 2.5 GPA in your college studies, and (2) your residence zip code is 97707. You are asked to *only* submit the following two items:

- ✓ A completed and signed Application Form
- ✓ A copy of your most current college/university transcript

- Hand-deliver all required items to the church office which is located in the Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Sunriver, Oregon – 18143 Cottonwood Rd., across the street from the Marketplace Store on Cottonwood Road no later than 4:00 pm on the deadline date.

Please do not send anything via e-mail.

Interview – this will be the same as before

- *All* applicants, regardless of which scholarship applying for, are required to have a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- An interview cannot be scheduled until the Scholarship Committee has received *all* required application pieces (e.g., completed Application Form and most current college transcript).
- You will be contacted within a week after all your application materials have been received in the church office to let you know they arrived safely.

- You will be contacted by phone the week following your scholarship deadline date to schedule your interview date and time. Recognizing that some colleges do not complete their spring term until early to mid-June, the committee is flexible in arranging your interview time. You have the option of either scheduling the interview after you complete finals and have returned home, or schedule it earlier if this is more convenient for you.
- As before, the interview will last no longer than twenty minutes. The committee will be interested to hear how your current year went, and how your future academic and career plans are becoming more clearly defined.
- Within one week of your interview, you will be informed by letter of the committee's decision.

Scholarship Application Deadlines & Interviews

Partial-Year Scholarship for 2019 Winter & Spring Terms

- **October 19, 2018** – completed scholarship application deadline
- **November 15, 2018** – all applicant interviews completed
- **November 19, 2018** – all applicants' notification completed

Full-Year Scholarships for the 2019-2020 Academic Year

- **April 26, 2019** – completed scholarship application deadline
- **May 24, 2019** – interviews of all high school graduating seniors and local college applicants completed
- **May 31, 2019** – all local applicants' notifications completed
