A Message from Joe Huseonica and the SCF Managing Board

The update on the HTCC “Planning for the Future” process, in which they are determining the overall feasibility of their Bishop’s requested direction for the building, is simply that there is nothing to report. Recent inquiries to the HTCC leadership have yielded no new information other than their process is continuing and they hope to reach a feasibility finding in the coming weeks. The Managing Board remains aware that time is waning with our existing lease and will continue to keep pressure on HTCC for an answer on direction.

The next area of update has to do with the process that the SCF Finance Committee and the Managing Board uses to determine our operating and ministry budgets for the coming year. Historically, we have first come to you with a stewardship pledge request without knowing what our financial needs would be for the coming year and then we have fit the budget requests into your pledge responses. This has meant that in some instances we have not been able to fully fund the requests for certain operating expenses and outreach ministries because the pledges did not support the requested budgets.

A new process has been defined by the Managing Board wherein we will begin the budgeting process for the coming year prior to the stewardship process by requesting proposed budgets for each of our operating expense categories and each of our outreach ministries. These individual budget requests will be fully vetted and approved by the Managing Board, rolled up into a total budget and then presented to you before the stewardship pledge process begins. These process changes will allow you to fully understand the financial needs of our congregation prior to making your stewardship pledge commitment.

Over the coming weeks, prior to the stewardship call in October, you will see the Managing Board reach out to each of outreach ministry team leaders and request that they prepare and submit for review and approval, their budget requests for the coming year. Once the stewardship pledge process is completed, the Finance Committee and the Managing Board will reconcile budget requests and the results of your pledge commitments.

As we have in years past, the Managing Board will then present this completed budget to the congregation for final review and approval at the annual meeting.

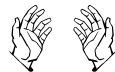

SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

The Scholarship Committee has awarded scholarships to 16 young people totaling \$28,800 so far this spring. A final applicant is still to be interviewed. On Sunday, June 3, nine recipients were available to attend the worship service and were acknowledged.

This year the committee awarded five of the scholarship to first-time applicants and we look forward to continuing our support towards their academic efforts in the coming years. At present, the program has awarded a total of \$166,650 in scholarship funds to 56 individuals of which 31 reapplied at least once.

SCF ENDOWMENT MOMENT

For the past two years, the SCF Endowment Fund has generously made contributions to Living Room Ministries International. LRMI is a registered NGO in Kenya and a 501 (c) (3) in California. Living Room was created to extend love in action by caring for those suffering from pain and symptoms associated with dying. LR built Kimbilio Hospice with 24 beds in the small village of Chebaiywa to offer hospice and palliative care services. It is only one of two in-patient hospices in Kenya, serving a population of 44 million people. LR quickly found from practical experience that they also care for many rehabilitative patients and malnourished children.

Because the need is so great, LR is currently building a second location, the Kimbilio Care Center in Eldoret, the 4th largest city in Kenya (about 90 minutes driving time from the current location). This center will provide care for 52 in-patient guests, as well as out-patients and home-based hospice services. LR continues to be passionate about its vision to create a community of compassion that honors life and offers hope.
